Assistant Professor in Energy Economics

beginning February 1st, 2011, or upon agreement. The position entails 4 hours of teaching per week (reduced to 2 hours per week during the first year). The successful applicant will establish and lead an interdisciplinary research group on “sustainable energy and water use.” The position is limited to 5 years.

Applicants should have a doctoral degree in economics or an adjoining field and experience in interdisciplinary research. A background in energy economics, industrial organization, applied econometrics, or environmental economics as well as a focus on empirical research would be advantageous.

The conditions of employment conform to the statutes and ordinances of the University of Basel (<http://www.unibas.ch>). The University of Basel aims at raising the share of female professors and thus especially welcomes female applicants.

Applications should include a curriculum vitae, a list of publications, two academic papers, a short description of the candidate’s experience in project acquisition and management, and at least one letter of recommendation.
