

Research fellows in economics and climate

CICERO Center for International Climate and Environmental Research has two open positions for researchers with an academic background in economics. Applicants should have experience from environmental or resource economics and an interest in climate and environmental issues. The vacant positions include work on research projects focusing on climate and technology and development economics, and entails working with micro- and macroeconomic models. A Ph.D. or equivalent is required.

The successful applicants are expected to develop and oversee their own projects and have good interpersonal skills. Emphasis is placed on time-management and follow-through skills, solid analytical and quantitative skills, and ability and willingness to participate in wide-ranging and interdisciplinary research projects. Information and outreach are key aspects of CICERO's activities, requiring excellent oral and written communication skills.

CICERO offers a good work environment with a research staff of 50, which comprises a wide range of disciplinary backgrounds, including political science, sociology, economics, and the natural sciences. Economists at CICERO conduct research in our three main research areas:

- International agreements and policy instruments
- Mitigation and costs
- Impacts, vulnerability and adaptation

This provides good opportunities for interdisciplinary collaboration, yet emphasis is placed on the development of researchers' individual interests within their specific discipline. CICERO participates in a broad network of research communities both nationally and internationally.
