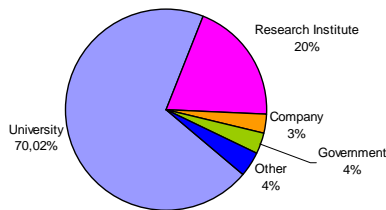

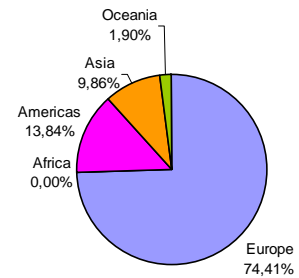

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP PROFILE 2011 REGIONS



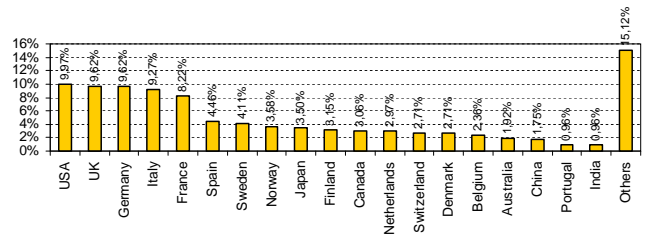
