SECOND WORKSHOP ON LANDSCAPE ECONOMICS

Date : 2007, June, 14th, 15, 16th

Place: SupAgro, 2 Place Viala, Montpellier, France

Landscapes' quality and diversity constitute a valuable resource for the Tourism Industry, and for the global and local economies as well. Nevertheless, landscape economics is still developing. It is a urgent task to adapt analytical concepts and tools in order to cope with future changes in land uses arising as a consequences of the climate change and the energy crisis. The aim of this second workshop is to contribute to this development.

This workshop is part of the global project of the European Consortium for Landscape Economics, CEEP, funded by the French Department of Environment and Sustainable Development (MEDD). The first workshop has been held in Angers, Spring 2006. The next step will be the International Conference on Landscape Economics, to be held in 2008 in Vienna.

The goal of the workshop is to gather academics and researchers and motivate them to focus on the analysis of several aspects of landscape economics. Special attention should be payed to accomodate the specific dimensions of the Landscape Economics. The Scientific Committee will praise proposals in the following area:

Policy Instruments for Actors' Coordination and Landscape Governance

Landscape Maintenance as an Economic Sector
