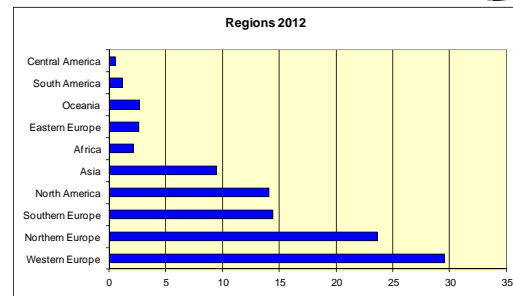
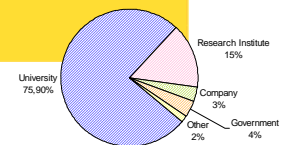

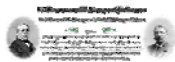

## Final Accounts 2011

Auditors (Santiago Rubio and Sjak Smulders) approved the accountings and urged the council:

1) to invest a portion of the Association's assets;

1) to establish an upper-bound over the assets of the Association to act as a buffer value but that all the money above this threshold should be reinvested in benefits for the membership. At least, the following options could be considered:

- i) A reduction in the levy over the fee for the conference.
- ii) More grants for the Ph.D. students both for those coming to the conference and those attending the summer school.
- iii) More money for the winners of the awards.
- iv) A payment for the faculty of the summer school.

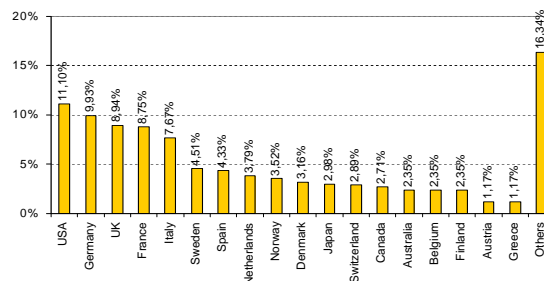
