Updates on the Economists' Statement on Carbon Pricing

Back in June 2019, the EAERE <u>Policy Outreach Committee</u> (POC) had prepared a statement on carbon pricing to be proposed for endorsement to the whole community of economists in Europe and worldwide. The Statement, launched at the Opening Ceremony of the EAERE 24th Annual Conference in Manchester last June, aims to convey the European perspective on carbon pricing and to draw the attention of policy-makers to its importance as a key instrument to achieve the future de-carbonization targets. EAERE President at 18th International Conference on Credit Risk Evaluation Designed for Institutional Targeting in finance (CREDIT)

On September 26, EAERE President Carlo Carraro opened the 18th edition of the <u>CREDIT Conference</u> in Venice, for which he was Chair of the Scientific Committee. He also chaired the *Climate Risk and Equity Markets* Session and took part to the Panel Session Practice *Climate Change Risk: A Practitioners' View* on Sept. 27. The objective of the CREDIT Conference is to bring together academics, practitioners and PhD students working in the area of risk management. This year's edition focused on *Assessing and Managing Climate Change Risk: Opportunities for Financial Institutions* and provided an opportunity for participants engaged in research at the forefront of this area to discuss both the causes and implications of recent financial and atmospheric events and suggest fruitful directions for future research.

EfD 13th Annual Meeting

The <u>EfD</u> Annual Meeting is the largest annual conference in the Global South on the application of environmental economics to development. This year's meeting will be held in Bogotá, Colombia, on 21-25 November 2019. On 21 November, a Policy Day will be organized by the EfD center at Universidad de Los Andes on the theme of Forests and Peace; the EfD Annual Meeting will be held on 22-25 November 2019. EfD is a capacity building program in research, training and policy advice, with centers in fifteen academic institutions in Central America, Chile, China, Colombia, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria, South Africa, Sweden, Tanzania, Uganda and USA. It is managed by the EfD Secretariat at the School of Business, Economics and Law of the University of Gothenburg, Sweden. It holds a conference each year hosted by one of its centers in the Global South.

Global Roundtable for Sustainable Shipping

The Global Roundtable for Sustainable Shipping initiative, developed by UN SDSN Greece - co-chaired by

Prof. Phoebe Koundouri and Prof. Andreas Papandreou and managed by Lydia Papadaki - aims at bringing together shipowners, shipbuilders, technology developers and researchers, ports and policy makers, on innovation related to zero emissions shipping, from across the globe, to target net-zero emissions by 2050. It will be launched at a specific session on the zero-carbon ocean shipping at the two-day <u>COP 25</u> in Santiago, Chile hosted by SDSN on December 9-10, 2019.



UN SDSN 4-Seas Initiative

The UN SDSN 4-Seas is a Euro-Asian Initiative that aims to mobilizing science driven sustainable blue growth in the Mediterranean Sea, the Black Sea, the Caspian Sea and the Aral Sea, in order to protect the future state of global seas and oceans by providing a Blue Sustainability Transition Plan "from rivers to the oceans". The initiative is led by SDSN Greece and SDSN Black Sea, established leaders on research for the implementation of SDGs in rivers and wetlands, coastal zones, seas and oceans, shipping, marine transport, offshore energy production, fishing, aquaculture, marine litter, and relevant education and training.

This new Report by IPCC highlights the urgency of prioritizing timely, ambitious and coordinated action to address unprecedented and enduring changes in the ocean and cryosphere. The report reveals the benefits of ambitious and effective adaptation for sustainable development and, conversely, the escalating costs and risks of delayed action.

United in Science Report

The world's leading climate science organizations have joined forces to produce a landmark new report for the United Nations Climate Action Summit (Sept. 23, 2019). The report includes details on the state of the climate and presents trends in the emissions and atmospheric concentrations of main greenhouse gases. It highlights the urgency of fundamental socio-economic transformation in key sectors such as land use and energy in order to avoid dangerous increases in global temperature with potentially irreversible impacts. It also examines tools to support both mitigation and adaptation strategies.

The report analyses and questions the current development model as not sustainable, and remarks that a more optimistic future entirely depends on drastically changing development policies, incentives and action.
