



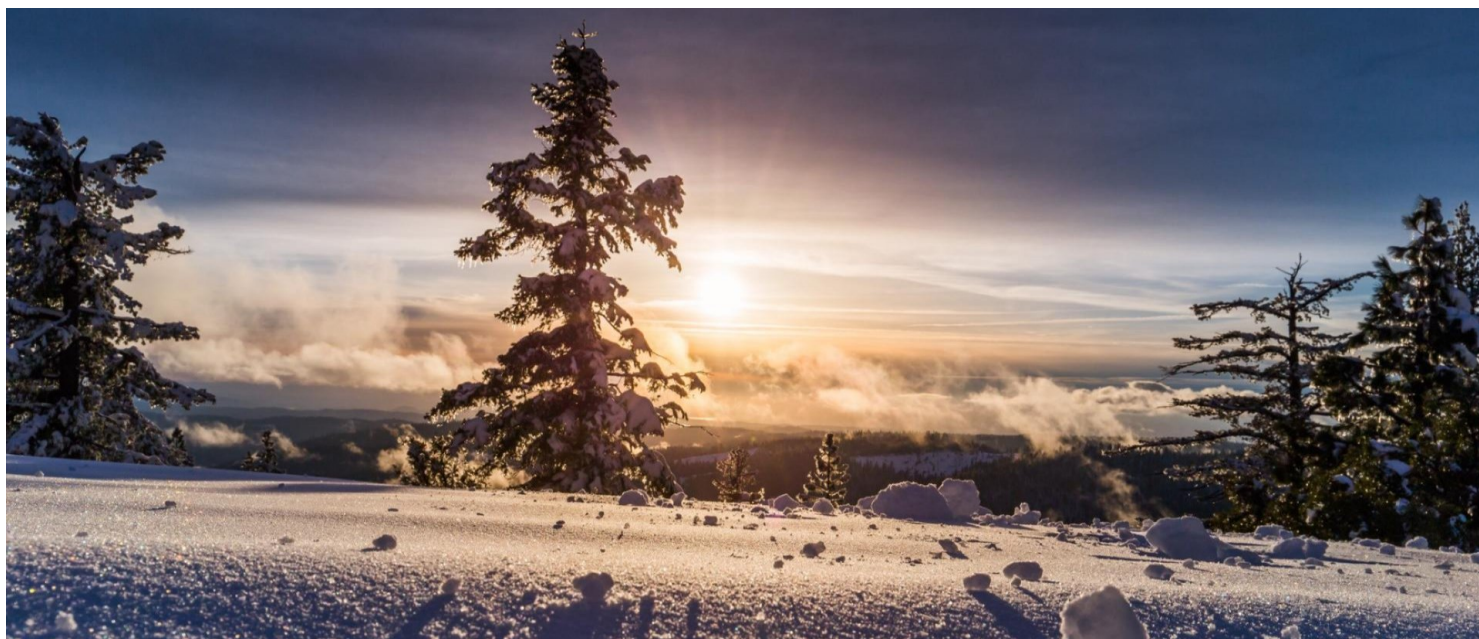

Update to EAERE Statute

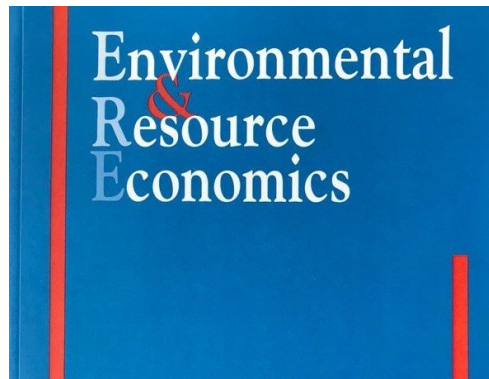

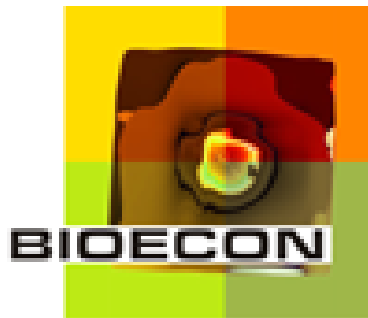

Call for papers for Routledge book "Behavioural Economics and the Environment"

Alessandro Buccioli (University of Verona - alessandro.buccioli@univr.it), Alessandro Tavoni (University of Bologna - alessandro.tavoni2@unibo.it) and Marcella Veronesi (University of Verona - marcella.veronesi@univr.it) are planning to edit a book for Routledge titled "*Behavioural Economics and the Environment*", scheduled to be published in July 2022. The book, which will contain contributions from experts in these fields, is primarily aimed at scholars who have recently begun doing research in this area (or are contemplating moving in this direction) and look for a comprehensive and rigorous overview of the state-of-the-art in behavioural environmental economics. Several esteemed researchers have already agreed to contribute to the volume. However, editors would like to add a **section on the environment, unexpected shocks (such as natural disasters or a pandemic), and their behavioural consequences**. New contributions or new versions of published works are accepted, as long as they contain new results that were not included in the original publication. Literature reviews are also welcome. First drafts of the papers should be sent by **July 31, 2021**.

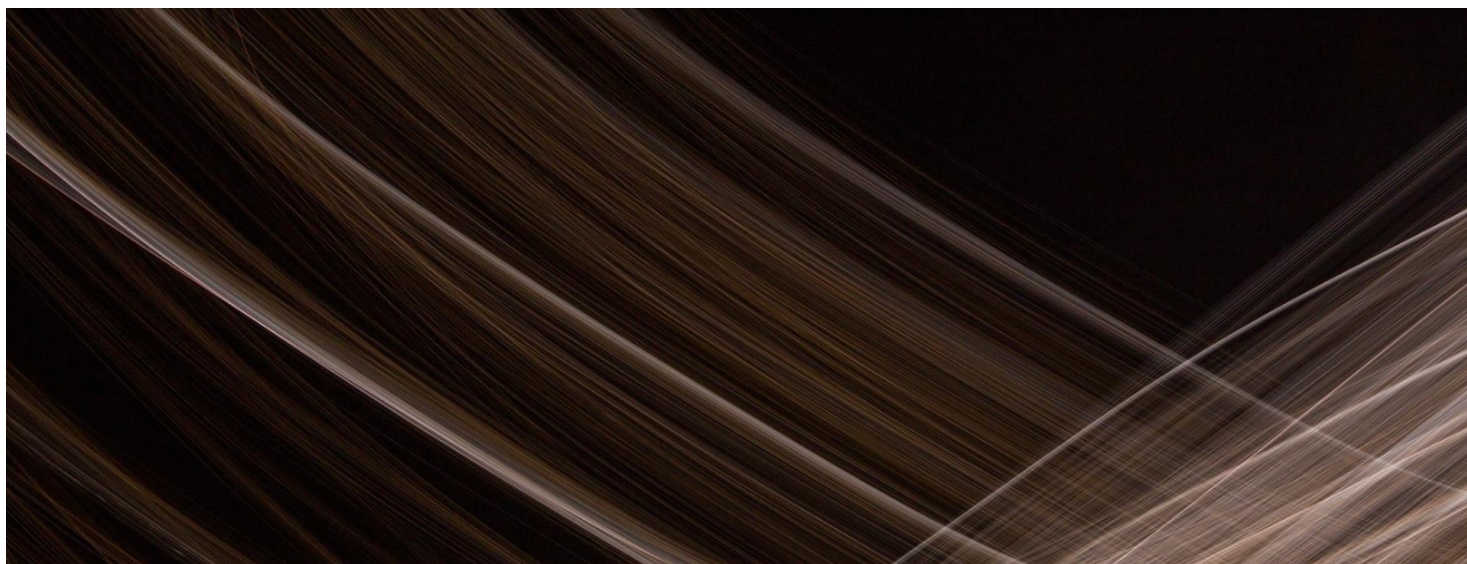


GGKP Expert Connect

GGGI Green Growth Index 2020

The *GGGI Green Growth Index 2020 - Measuring performance in achieving SDG targets* is a technical report published by the Global Green Growth Institute in collaboration with other expert partners such as the World Bank Group, UNEP and FAO. It saw the contribution of many distinguished authors from governments, the scientific community and the private sector/NGOs. The Green Growth Index measures a country's performance in achieving sustainability targets including Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), Paris Climate Agreement, and Aichi Biodiversity Targets for four green growth dimensions – efficient and sustainable resource use, natural capital protection, green economic opportunities, and social inclusion (Acosta et al., 2019a).
