Important Announcement Regarding WCERE 2022

The World Council of Environmental and Resource Economics Associations (WCEREA) was tasked by its member associations <u>AAERE</u>, <u>AERE</u>, and <u>EAERE</u> with planning and executing the 7th World Congress of Environmental and Resource Economists in 2022. The continuing uncertainty about the pace of COVID-19 vaccinations, the economics conditions, and when societies will return to normal (and what normal will look like) have created challenges for making the fiscal and organizational commitments needed now to hold the event next year. Given this, and in consultation with the member associations and candidate local organizers, the WCEREA has decided to **postpone the 7th World Congress until summer 2023.** More information will follow.

The Future Europe Wants: A Green and Digital, Job-Based and Inclusive Recovery

In an attempt to connect the dots between four major policy initiatives – the SDGs, the European Green Deal, the European Semester, and the EU recovery plan – the Sustainable Development Solutions Network Europe (SDSN Europe) has produced a new report, Transformations for the Joint Implementation of Agenda 2030, the Sustainable Development Goals and the European Green Deal: A Green and Digital, Job-Based and Inclusive Recovery from COVID-19 Pandemic, to support policymakers with actionable strategies that can guide EU-wide and national economic recovery in line with the continent's overarching sustainability agenda. Key recommendations and findings from the report were presented in an online event on February 18, 2021. EAERE President-elect Prof. Phoebe Koundouri was among the speakers of the event.

Call for papers for Routledge book "Behavioural Economics and the Environment"

Alessandro Bucciol (University of Verona - alessandro.bucciol@univr.it), Alessandro Tavoni (University of Bologna alessandro.tavoni2@unibo.it) and Marcella Veronesi (University - marcella.veronesi@univr.it) are planning to edit a book for Routledge titled "Behavioural Economics and the Environment", scheduled to be published in July 2022. The book, which will contain contributions from experts in these fields, is primarily aimed at scholars who have recently begun doing research in this area (or are contemplating moving in this direction) and look for a comprehensive and rigorous overview of the state-ofthe-art in behavioural environmental economics. Several esteemed researchers have already agreed to contribute to the volume. However, editors would like to add a section on the environment, unexpected shocks (such as natural disasters or a pandemic), and their behavioural consequences. New contributions or new versions of published works are accepted, as long as they contain new results that were not included in the original publication. Literature reviews are also welcome. First drafts of the papers should be sent by July 31, 2021.

EU Climate Adaptation Strategy

The European Commission has adopted its new *EU strategy on adaptation to climate change* on 24 February 2021. The new strategy aims to set out ways in which the EU can adapt to the unavoidable impacts of climate change and become climate resilient by 2050. The Strategy has four main objectives: to make adaptation smarter, swifter and more systemic, and to step up international action for climate resilience.

The fifth edition of the *UNEP Adaptation Gap Report* assesses progress in planning for, financing and implementing adaptation, with a focus on nature-based solutions. The Report finds that while governments have made progress in planning, financing for developing countries is still behind, such as a complete implementation of adaptation projects to the stage where they bring real protection against climate impacts. The People's Climate Vote

The Peoples' Climate Vote is the largest survey of public opinion on climate change ever conducted, with 1.2 million respondents; results include 50 countries and cover 56% of the world population. The Peoples' Climate Vote is a pillar of the Mission 1.5 campaign launched in 2020 by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and partners to educate people about climate change solutions and ask them about the actions that they think governments should take.
