Second CEPR/EAERE webinar on Climate Policy: Pandemic stimulus spending and the fight against climate change

Climate change is a long term threat to human societies with expected huge impacts on health, economies and welfare. Somehow similar to a pandemic, but with more persistent and irreversible consequences. Even more than the fight against Covid-19, climate change control is a difficult

and complex task, which requires well-designed policies and important financial resources. This webinar will analyse these issues starting from lessons from past pandemics and then focusing on the implications of recovery plans for the fight against climate change. Speakers are **Massimo Tavoni**, Director of the European Institute on Environmental Economics (EIEE) and **Ioana Petrescu**, Senior fellow at the Mossavar-Rahmani Center for Business and Government at the Harvard Kennedy School and a former Romanian finance Minister. A moderated discussion will follow with **Andrea Tilche**, adjunct Professor at NTNU in Trondheim and former Director of the Environment Directorate of DG Research & Innovation and **Danielle Arostegui**, EDF Senior Analyst of Climate Policy.

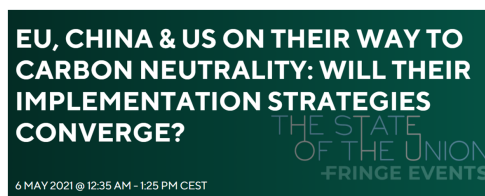

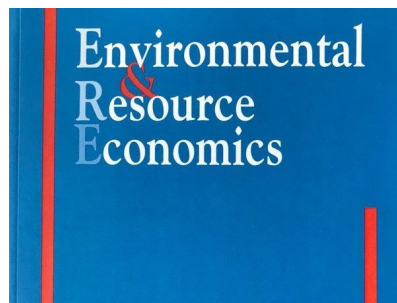

The Special Issue aims to collect empirical and theoretical papers primarily, although not exclusively, devoted to understand the prospect of the UE economies with respect to projected scenarios of climate change and the effects of mitigation policies across sectors and locations. Contributions on Italy and comparative studies will be welcome too, as well as spin-offs of already published articles or more ambitious working/job market papers.

Alessandro Buccioli (University of Verona - alessandro.buccioli@univr.it), Alessandro Tavoni (University of Bologna - alessandro.tavoni2@unibo.it) and Marcella Veronesi (University of Verona - marcella.veronesi@univr.it) are planning to edit a book for Routledge titled "*Behavioural Economics and the Environment*", scheduled to be published in July 2022. The book, which will contain contributions from experts in these fields, is primarily aimed at scholars who have recently begun doing research in this area (or are contemplating moving in this direction) and look for a comprehensive and rigorous overview of the state-of-the-art in behavioural environmental economics. Several esteemed researchers have already agreed to contribute to the volume. However, editors would like to add a **section on the environment, unexpected shocks (such as natural disasters or a pandemic), and their behavioural consequences**. New contributions or new versions of published works are accepted, as long as they contain new results that were not included in the original publication. Literature reviews are also welcome.

First drafts of the papers should be sent by **31 July 2021**.

These are regenerative resources, churning out goods and services, and shrinking if you take more out of the flow than it provides. They provide services we can use so long as consumption doesn't exceed the supply."

"In a review of the additional costs needed to meet the selected SDGs where natural capital has a major role, we estimate a need of about \$774 billion per year in global private and public investment. That means procuring and diverting financial resources to create or protect natural capital, such as land remediation, improvements in air and water, reductions in greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, and conserving or strengthening natural ecosystems."
