







#### **EAERE Elections 2021 - Results**

This year's EAERE Elections terminated on July 10th, 2021. 53,33% of our membership took part in the elections (8.52% more than in 2019).

For the position of President-Elect, the candidates were Simone Borghesi and Valentina Bosetti. Simone Borghesi was elected with 51,86% of votes. His two-year presidential term will begin in January 2024. He will serve as President-Elect in 2022 and 2023 and for other two years as Past-President, at the end of the presidential term. For the position of ordinary Council members, the set of candidates was comprised of Enrica De Cian, Klaus Eisenack, Mads Greaker and Åsa Löfgren. Åsa Löfgren and Enrica De Cian were elected, with 53,78% and 49,58% of votes respectively. They will serve for four years beginning in January 2022. We would like to thank all the candidates for participating in the elections and wish the new President-Elect and the new Council Members every success!

### Third CEPR/EAERE webinar on climate policy: The European Green Deal - video-recording available

The third CEPR/EAERE Webinar on Climate Policy: **The European Green Deal** took place on **Friday 16 July 2021**, **17:00 – 18:30 CEST**. In this event, Stefanie Hiesinger, Member of Cabinet of the Executive Vice-President for the European Green Deal, and Frans Timmermans at the European Commission, introduced us to the key insights of the "Fit for 55" proposal, followed by a description of his perspective by Peter Liese as Member of the European Parliament and a commentary by Arthur Runge-Metzger, Director for Climate Strategy, Governance, Emissions from Non-Trading Sectors at the European Commission's Directorate General for Climate Action. Finally, Ottmar Edenhofer, Member of the EAERE POC and Director of the Potsdam-Institute for Climate Impact Research (PIK), shared his views on a whole economy carbon price for

Europe and how this goal can be reached. The event was moderated by Brigitte Knopf, Secretary General of the Mercator Research Institute on Global Commons and Climate Change (MCC).

#### Call for papers for Routledge book "Behavioural Economics and the Environment"

Alessandro Bucciol (University of Verona - alessandro.bucciol@univr.it), Alessandro Tavoni (University of Bologna alessandro.tavoni2@unibo.it) and Marcella Veronesi (University Verona - marcella.veronesi@univr.it) are planning to edit a book for Routledge titled "Behavioural Economics and the Environment", scheduled to be published in July 2022. The book, which will contain contributions from experts in these fields, is primarily aimed at scholars who have recently begun doing research in this area (or are contemplating moving in this direction) and look for a comprehensive and rigorous overview of the state-of-the-art in behavioural environmental economics. Several esteemed researchers have already agreed to contribute to the volume. However, editors would like to add a section on the environment, unexpected shocks (such as natural disasters or a pandemic), and their behavioural consequences. New contributions or new versions of published works are accepted, as long as they contain new results that were not included in the original publication. Literature reviews are also welcome. First drafts of the papers should be sent by 31 July 2021.




#### **GGKP Expert Connect**

### European Green Deal: Commission proposes transformation of EU economy and society to meet climate ambitions

On 14 July 2021, the European Commission adopted a package of proposals to make the EU's climate, energy, land use, transport and taxation **policies fit for reducing net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030**, compared to 1990 levels ("Fit for 55"). Achieving these emission reductions in the next decade is crucial to Europe becoming the world's first climate-neutral continent by 2050 and making the European Green Deal a reality. With these proposals, the Commission is presenting the legislative tools to **deliver on the targets agreed in the European Climate Law** and fundamentally transform our economy and society for a fair, green and prosperous future.

#### **Explaining the costs of climate policy**

In the referendum campaign for the CO2 law in Switzerland, the costs of climate policy were massively brought to the fore. The cost argument was a major factor in the bill's failure in the public vote. The former US administration stressed the cost of the policy as the motivation for the US withdrawal from the Paris Climate Agreement. It is therefore important that the cost experts, i.e. the economists, take an even clearer stand on this point in the future. In this context, it seems to be purposeful to link up with simple models that are often used in the applied literature. The paper "Getting the Costs of Environmental Protection Right" just published in Ecological Economics aims to make a contribution in this respect, it can be read <a href="here">here</a>

### European Green Deal: the European Commission proposes new strategy to protect and restore EU forests

On 16 July 2021, the European Commission adopted the <u>New EU Forest Strategy for 2030</u>, a flagship initiative of the <u>European Green Deal</u> that builds on the EU <u>Biodiversity Strategy for 2030</u>. The strategy contributes to the <u>package of measures</u> proposed to achieve greenhouse gas emission reductions of at least 55% by 2030 and climate neutrality in 2050 in the EU.




