This year's theme was "Behavioral Environmental Economics". The lectures given by the faculty members were considered very interesting, clearly structured, and appropriate in terms of difficulty and interaction. Students stressed that the chance to talk with faculty members outside the scheduled programme was especially valuable.

EAERE-ETH Winter Schools

EAERE President <u>Phoebe Koundouri</u> has been elected member of <u>Academia Europaea</u>, in the section <u>Economics</u>, <u>Business and Management Sciences</u>. This section includes 156 members in total. <u>Academia Europaea</u> is a European non-governmental association having about 4,500 members including 70 Nobel laureates. This Academy aims to support European research, provide advice to policymakers and international organisations on scientific issues and promote interdisciplinary and international research. The World Academy of Art and Science was founded in 1960 on the initiative of Albert Einstein and Robert Oppenheimer. Today the Academy is composed of about 800 Fellows from 90 countries, including scientists, leading artists, politicians, statesmen, heads of research institutes and international organizations, Nobel Prize winners, and business leaders.

Launch of the SDSN Global Climate Hub

The SDSN Global Climate Hub was launched on the 6th of July, in a pre-COP27 event that took place at the Academy of Athens. The SDSN Global Climate Hub was announced by Jeffrey Sachs and Maria Cortes-Puch. The Chair of the SDSN Global Climate Hub will be EAERE President Phoebe Koundouri, while Yannis loannidis, Christos S. Zerefos and Andreas Papandreou will support the Hub as Co-Founders. The Hosts of the Global Climate Hub are Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) and the Athena Research & Innovation Center in Information Communication & Knowledge Technologies both of which belong to the Alliance of Excellence for Research and Innovation on Aephoria (AE4RIA) directed by Phoebe Koundouri. EAERE at ECHA: periodical report

Since 2012 EAERE has observer status at meetings of the Socio-Economic Assessment Committee (SEAC) convened at the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in Helsinki under REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals). Dr. Mike Holland (Ecometrics Research and Consulting – EMRC, and Imperial College London) and Prof. Roy Brower (University of Waterloo) are the current EAERE delegates. EAERE's position as a stakeholder organisation has developed to provide advice to the REACH process on the application of environmental economics. EAERE representatives do not lobby specifically for adoption or rejection of any proposals made, but provide comment on the science underpinning the arguments made. New Public Consultations launched by the European Commission


