EAERE 2023: Call for Policy and Thematic Sessions

We look forward to welcoming you in the island of Cyprus for the 28th Annual Conference of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists on 27-30 June 2023! The conference will take place in presence in the coastal city of Limassol, while including some hybrid events as part of the programme. There will be two types of pre-organised sessions at EAERE 2023 for which proposals are now invited: Policy Sessions and Thematic Sessions. Both sessions will be held in hybrid format. However, all papers must be presented by an author who will be present in-person at the conference. The deadline for submission for both sessions is 31 January 2023. Embassy of The Kingdom of The Netherlands in Greece Dutch-Greek Economic Session I Farming the Future: Water & Energy efficiency for Agriculture in Greece

His Majesty King Willem-Alexander and Her Majesty Queen Máxima payed a state visit to Greece, at the invitation of President Katerina Sakellaropoulou. The visit took place from Monday 31 October to Wednesday 2 November in Athens and Thessaloniki and focused on issues including cooperation on innovation, sustainability, migration and human rights, and the countries' partnership within the European Union. On Tuesday 2 November, the King and Queen attended an Economic Session on sustainability and agriculture entitled "Farming the Future: Water & Energy efficiency for Agriculture in Greece" in Thessaloniki. Representatives from the Dutch Ministry of Agriculture Nature and Food Quality, Netherlands Enterprise Agency, and Enterprise Greece joined the session. Around 30 companies from The Netherlands and Greece were present, and more than 60 match-making discussions took place. Phoebe Koundouri, as a professor of Environmental Economics and a leader in sustainable development, was invited by the Embassy of the Netherlands to moderate the entire session. Learn more here

Coping with increasing tides: evolving agglomeration dynamics and technological change under exacerbating hazards

By 2050, about 70% of the world's population is expected to live in cities. Cities offer spatial economic advantages that boost agglomeration forces and innovation, fostering further concentration of economic activities. For historic reasons urban centers cluster along coasts, which are prone to climate-induced flooding and sea level rise. Have a look at the <u>new paper</u> published on Ecological Economics (Elsevier) and authored by Tatiana Filatova (TU Delft)

and her team within their ERC project on scaling up behavior and autonomous adaptation for macro models on climate change damage assessment.

I am Elvia Rufo, PhD candidate at the Institute for Environmental Studies, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. My PhD is funded through the European Innovative Training Network Programme (ITN) in the project PRORISK. In the text attached, I share my experiences working with dangerous chemicals as a trainee in the European Chemicals Agency for 6 months, including my own view on the regulatory REACH framework and the importance of economic valuation to support this legislation. I also briefly describe the Surveys on Willingness to Pay to Avoid Negative Chemicals-Related Health Impacts (SWACHE) led by the OECD.

The speakers and moderators engaged each other and the audience in conversations about findings from the IPCC reports, why they matter, and how they can be and are being used to mobilize more ambitious and equitable actions on climate change. 
Ideas into action
