### SAVE THE DATE: EAERE 29th Annual Conference




International Conference on Ex-Post Evaluation of Emission Trading: call for papers

### Synthesis Report of the IPCC Sixth Assessment Report

The IPCC finalized the Synthesis Report for the Sixth Assessment Report during the Panel's 58th Session held in Interlaken, Switzerland from 13-19 March 2023. This structure, substantially different to what was adopted for AR5 SYR, enables a holistic framing that integrates across the Working Groups, better enabling the SYR to cover different aspects of climate change.
