SAVE THE DATE: EAERE 29th Annual Conference



"How to strengthen the EU's leadership on the SDGs Civil society and expert contributions for the UN HLPF and beyond" online event

On Wednesday, 4th of April, the <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> (EESC) and the <u>Sustainable Development Solutions Network</u> (SDNS) organized the online event 'How to strengthen the EU Leadership on the SDGs – Civil Society's and Experts' Contribution to the UN HLPF and beyond, which took place at the EESC headquarters in Brussels. The workshop aimed to discuss priorities to strengthen the European Union's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) leadership in achieving climate neutrality and sustainable development, both at home and internationally, ahead of major international summits – including the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development in July, and the SDG Summit in New York in September. EAERE President <u>Phoebe Koundouri</u> was invited to moderate the panel discussion on "Academic Contributions: Systemic Solutions for wicked challenges". An outcome document will be prepared based on the main conclusions of the meeting, which will aim to support informed discussions on SDG priorities for the EU at HLPF, the SDG Summit in 2023, and the Summit of the Future in 2024.

Bård Harstad receives the prize for Outstanding Research in the Humanities and Social Sciences

Prof. Bård Harstad (University of Oslo) received the prize for **Outstanding Research in the Humanities and Social Sciences** (HumSam-prisen) from The Norwegian Academy of Science and Letters. The prize is awarded biannually to a scientist within the humanities or social sciences, including law, theology and education. Harstad received the prize last **March 13th** for his outstanding contributions to political economy and environmental economics. At the event, he gave a talk on the topic "Is economic efficiency politically possible?". XXIV Annual BIOECON Conference on "Biodiversity and the Sustainable Development Goals"




GGKP Expert Connect

Call for Applications - Knowledge Brokerage Programme for Early to Mid Career Researchers


