Climate Policies, Macroprudential Regulation, and the Welfare Cost of Business Cycles

This study compares the performance of a carbon tax and a cap-and-trade scheme in a dynamic stochastic general equilibrium model that includes an environmental externality and agency problems associated with financial intermediation. Heterogeneous polluting firms purchase capital by combining their resources with loans from banks and are hit by idiosyncratic shocks that can lead them to default. The analysis finds that financial market distortions strongly affect the performance of climate policy throughout the business cycle.

Green Growth and Natural Capital in Europe: Evidence of the Last 25 Years

This paper reviews trends in natural capital against those of GDP across Europe to compare how green growth has been over the last quarter century. The results are compared with more conventional indices of green growth and reasons for intra-country differences in both measures are discussed. Professor Anil Markandya has worked extensively on environmental problems from an economic viewpoint. He earned a Masters in Econometrics and a PhD from the London School of Economics. He published widely on resource valuation and regulation in the context of sustainable development.

Underprepared – Inadequate investment and planning on climate adaptation leaves world exposed* finds that progress on climate adaptation is slowing when it should be accelerating to catch up with these rising climate change impacts.


Cyprus Economy's Path to Climate Neutrality

The Cyprus Institute, EAERE institutional member, has prepared the first comprehensive study for the transition of Cyprus to a net-zero economy by 2050. The study involved detailed energy-economy-emissions modeling of a central net-zero scenario with sensitivity analyses. Based on model-based findings, the study assesses the necessary public and private investments up to 2050 and provides an outline of the fiscal and broader macroeconomic challenges and opportunities for the net-zero transition of the Cypriot economy. The report has been widely disseminated in the country with a view to stimulating discussions among stakeholders and assisting national authorities to update the country's low-emission development strategy in 2024.
