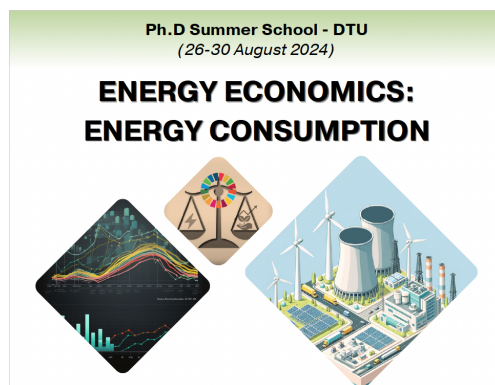
Webinar: Cooperatives and sustainable development
