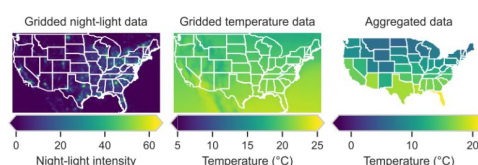

Weighted Climate Data Repository

Although high-resolution gridded climate variables are provided by multiple sources, the need for country and region-specific climate data weighted by indicators of economic activity is becoming increasingly common in environmental and economic research. A team of researchers composed by [Marco Gortan](#), [Lorenzo Testa](#), [Giorgio Fagiolo](#) and [Francesco Lamperti](#) process available information from different climate data sources to provide spatially aggregated data with global coverage for both countries (GADM0 resolution) and regions (GADM1 resolution) and for a variety of climate indicators (average precipitations, average temperatures, average SPEI). The repository is available [here](#).

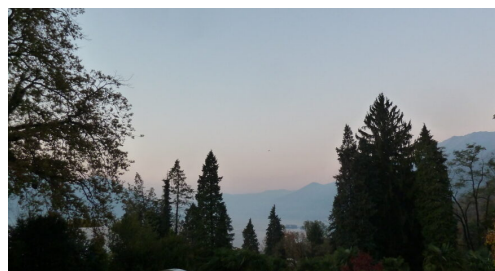

The **First REE/JEEM Workshop on Nonmarket Valuation** will be held on **5 July 2024** at **KU Leuven, Belgium**. This workshop will be staged immediately following #EAERE2024 and will consist of a pre-conference dinner on 4 July followed by a full day of presentations on 5 July.

The Call for Papers is **now open**. Authors are invited to submit empirical and theoretical papers on any topic related to the nonmarket valuation of environmental and natural resources. Papers may cover revealed preference (e.g., hedonics, travel cost, averting behavior), stated preference (e.g., contingent valuation, choice experiments), or benefit transfer applications, along with related topics such as the application of nonmarket valuation methods to natural capital accounting. Preparation for the Ocean and Climate Change Dialogue 2024: Virtual Informal Exchange of Views

As an UNFCCC observer organisation, EAERE is invited to a virtual informal exchange of views on the preparation for the Ocean and Climate Change Dialogue 2024, to be held in conjunction with the sixtieth session of the subsidiary bodies (June 2024). There will be two slots to hear views on: i) Topics for the dialogue; ii) The structure of the dialogue, including specific questions to be addressed; iii) Expectations on the outcomes of the dialogue. The virtual meetings have been organised in two different timings to allow participation from different time zones:

Thursday, 7 March 2024 13:00 to 15:00 (GMT)

DEARE Day in Utrecht, Netherlands

On February 2, the third Dutch Environmental and Resource Economists (DEARE) day took place in Utrecht, after similar events in Tilburg (2022) and Amsterdam (2023). Many of Netherland-based EAERE members attended the one-day event, at which about 25 recent papers by mainly young researchers working in Dutch Universities were presented.
