New paper: "Nudging when the descriptive norm is low: Evidence from a carbon offsetting field experiment" available for short time

The paper "Nudging when the descriptive norm is low: Evidence from a carbon offsetting field experiment" by Stefano Carattini and Julia Blasch has been published on the Journal of Behavioral and Experimental Economics (Elsevier). The paper includes results from the field experiments conducted in June 2016, when the EAERE annual conference took place in Zurich, Switzerland, and in June 2017, when the EAERE annual conference took place in Athens, Greece.

The 7th STS forum European Workshop - Royal Society in London

On April 8th, Professor **Phoebe Koundouri** delivered a speech at the prestigious [Royal Society in London](#) for the High-level Conference of Political, Industrial, and Academic Leaders - [the Seventh STS forum European Workshop](#). Among the distinguished speakers were **Nobel laureates**, including Professor Emeritus **David Baulcombe** from the University of Cambridge, Professor **Sophien Kamoun** from The Sainsbury Laboratory in Norwich, **Didier Toubia**, Co-Founder and CEO of Aleph Farms, Israel and more. The panel discussion focused on the Future of Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security. Prof. Koundouri presented the [UN SDSN Global Climate Hub](#) which provides a holistic, interdisciplinary, and intra-disciplinary method that derives science-based dynamic and spatial food systems pathways, meeting national and international goals of food security, biodiversity, and climate goals and she shared the Hub's method and results.



Prof. Phoebe Koundouri's Leadership Sustainability Initiatives at Academia Europaea

Prof. Phoebe Koundouri is the new co-chair of the [Task Force on Environment, Sustainability, and Climate \(TFESC\)](#) at of [Academia Europaea](#). The primary aim of this initiative is to explore innovative strategies for advancing Healthy Food and Sustainable Agriculture in Europe, with a global outlook. Additionally, Prof. Koundouri represents AE in Task Force 2 "Bioeconomy" as an expert in the S20 Task Forces. Academia Europaea has been invited to join the S20 group, acting as the European-wide academy for the G20 nations. The S20 serves as the science advisory body for the G20 Heads of State, with the Brazilian Academy of Science and the Brazilian government hosting the 2024 meetings. The Brazilian Academy of Science has crafted a policy

advice document titled "Science for Global Transformation," to be refined by 5 Task Forces focusing on various topics.

UNFCCC Submission Tracker

The [UNFCCC Submissions Tracker](#), a new tool created by Earth Negotiations Bulletin, pulls together the UNFCCC's calls for submission across its full range of issues, items, and bodies. The spreadsheet lists the submission deadlines, types of actors the calls are open to, what content is required for the submission, and what follow up you can expect. We have also described the broader context around each submission and linked to the UNFCCC document where each call was first shared.

Expert dialogue on children and climate change: Call for Input

An expert dialogue on children and climate change to discuss the disproportionate impacts of climate change on children, and relevant policy solutions in this regard, will be held during the sixtieth session of the Subsidiary Bodies to be held in Bonn, Germany from 3 to 13 June 2024. The agenda for the expert dialogue will be shared in due course.
