"Benefit-Cost Analysis: Valuing Life and Health" online programme, 16-20 Sept. 2024

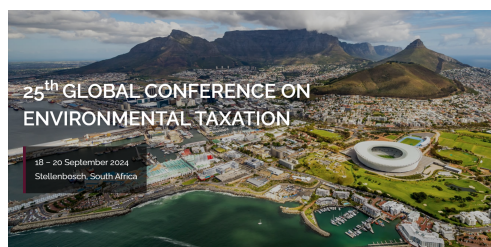
