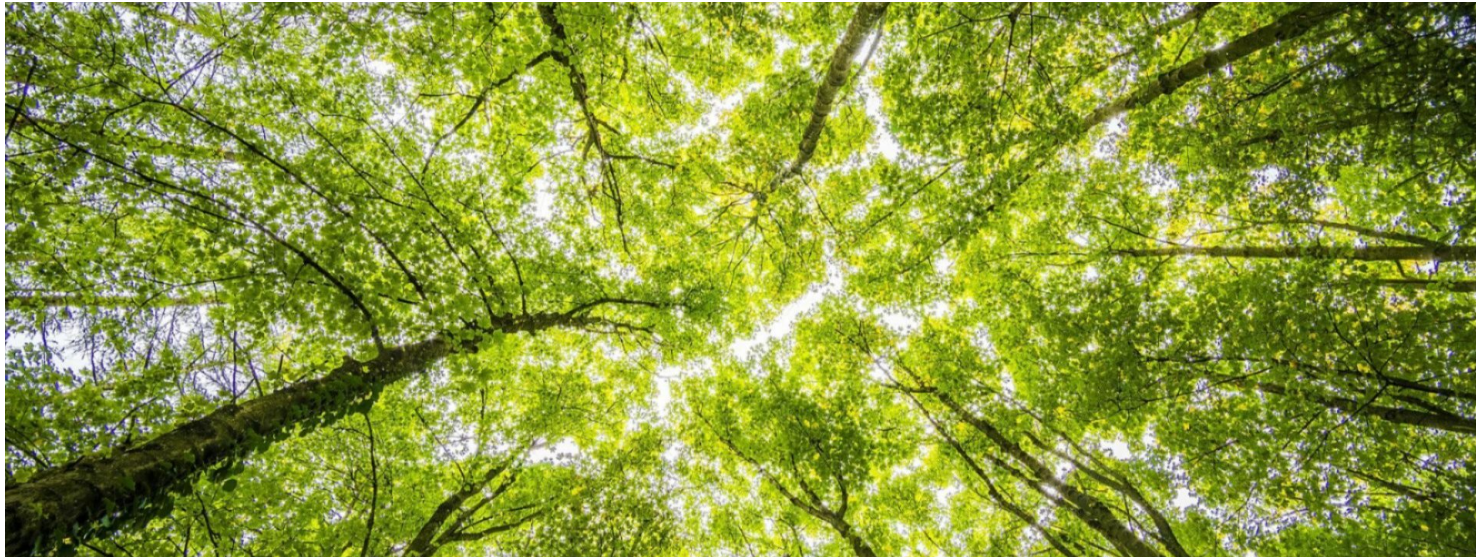

EAERE 2024 related event: High-level roundtable on climate negotiations

The [high-level roundtable on climate negotiations](#) took place as an EAERE 2024 pre-conference event on June 30, 2024 at KU Leuven, Belgium. The roundtable, organised by Adrien Fabre (CNRS France) and Sareh Vosooghi (KU Leuven), gathered **12 experts from all continents and diverse positions** (diplomats, scholars, civil society...). The experts agreed on a range of issues. Central to the discussion was the need to **expand climate finance to the Global South**.

The EU & ANR projects IAM-Circ, Circomod, CircEular, and ScarCycLET, in collaboration with the European Association of Young Economists (EAYE), hosted a [workshop on Circular Economy Economic Modelling](#) on July 1, 2024. The [REE/JEEM Workshop on Nonmarket Valuation](#) was held as a Post-Conference event on July 5, 2024. It featured **9 papers on theory, methods and applications in environmental valuation**, which were discussed in depth by 39 workshop attendees. The event was organized by Robert Johnston (Clark University), Roger von Haefen (North Carolina State University), Klaus Moeltner (Virginia Tech) and Sandra Rousseau (KU Leuven University), and co-sponsored by the journals [Resource and Energy Economics](#) and the [Journal of Environmental Economics and Management](#). A **special issue with selected papers** from the 2024 workshop is scheduled to appear in **REE**. A parallel workshop is planned for 2025, with selected papers to be featured in a special JEEM issue.

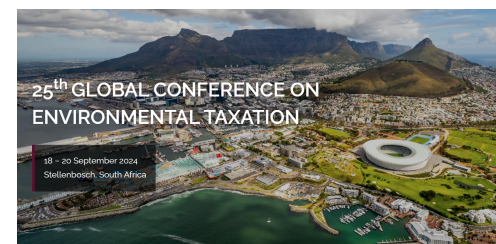
EAERE Supported Event: EU-SUSEET, Naples (Italy), 9-14 Sep 2024

The **Environmental Economics Group** of the EAERE member [Institute for Public Goods and Policies of the Spanish National Research Council \(IPP-CSIC\)](#) is glad to share that the Institute contributes to the economic analysis of public support for the decarbonised energy transition for the **Horizon 2020 project AURES II** (PI: [Pablo Del Río](#)), and to the economic analysis of the determinants and outcomes of environmental innovation for the **Horizon Europe project CaLby2030** (research team: [Pablo Del Río](#) and [Christoph Kiefer](#)). Furthermore, the IPP-CSIC analyses the feasibility and sustainability of forest carbon offsetting for supporting net-zero objectives within the **Forest Carbon research line** (PI: [Paola Ovando](#)).



How Air Quality Affects Engagement, Politeness, and Quality in Conference Sessions: a survey

Ludovica Gazze (University of Warwick), Allen Huang (University of Oxford), Santiago Saavedra (Universidad del Rosario), and Mattie Toma (University of Warwick) conducted an experiment in which they randomly assigned **air pollution filters to rooms at economic conferences** and launched a **survey** to gather respondents' perceptions of different outcomes in the experiment that might be associated with air quality at conferences. EAERE 2024 Policy Session on the contribution of environmental economists to the IPCC process

The policy session "**The forthcoming 7th IPCC Assessment Report. What role is there for environmental economists?**", held during EAERE 2024 and chaired by Simone Borghesi, aimed at discussing modalities and strategies to stimulate more economic research to be embedded in the IPCC 7th Assessment Cycle and more in general in IPCC processes, including covering research innovation gaps. The session featured Philippe Tulkens (EU Commission – DG Research and Innovation) as well as the EAERE members Jos Delbeke, Phoebe Koundouri, Xavier Labandeira, Jan Minx and Massimo Tavoni. EAERE at IPCC: 61st Session | Sofia, 27 July - 2 August 2024

The IPCC Panel will meet for its 61st Session ([IPCC-61](#)) from **27 July to 2 August in Sofia**, Bulgaria. Several important topics are to be considered by IPCC including the strategic planning schedule for the cycle following the products the Panel decided to prepare at its 60th Session. Member Governments are also expected to consider and agree on the two report outlines: the one for the Special Report on Climate Change and Cities and the other for the Methodology Report on Short-Lived Climate Forcers. External review of the IPBES business and biodiversity assessment

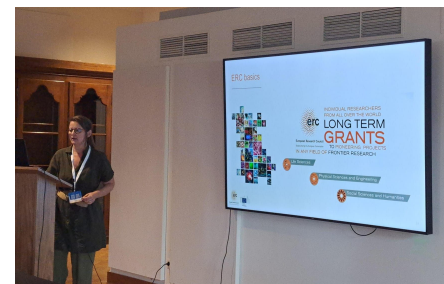
The [Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services \(IPBES\)](#) has announced the external review of the methodological assessment of the impact and dependence of business on biodiversity and nature's contributions to people. During this external review, the first draft of the chapters and the first draft of the summary for policymakers will be made available for review for a period of 8 weeks, **from 24 July to 17 September 2024**. To ensure the highest scientific quality and policy relevance of the assessment, the Multidisciplinary Expert Panel is seeking peer review from the widest-possible participation of experts from all relevant disciplines and backgrounds. GREEN TIPPING - From Niches to Norms: Drivers and Diffusion of Green Social Tipping, Alessandro Tavoni

[GREEN TIPPING](#) is a 5-year ERC project on how targeted social tipping interventions can spur sustainable choices, with surveys, lab and field experiments. It is run by an international team of researchers based at the University of Bologna's economics department. The project was officially kicked off at the "[Bologna workshop on Climate action and social tipping](#)", held on 12 April 2024. Team members and invited speakers (Karine Nyborg from the University of Oslo, Christoph Semken from Stanford University, Davide

Pace from LMU Munich and Roweno Heijmans of the Norwegian School of Economics) presented their work on issues ranging from moral responsibility, marginal impact of emission reductions to increasing public support for climate policies. Two publications have been published so far by the Green Tipping team: "Climate clubs in the laboratory" in the *Journal of Behavioral and Experimental Economics* and the "From niches to norms: the promise of social tipping interventions to scale climate action" in *npj | climate action*. Currently, the team is advancing on theory and piloting online survey experiments and lab experiments.
