Financially, hybrid conferences require substantial investments in technology and infrastructure to facilitate seamless virtual participation. The **2024 Conference of the [New Zealand Agricultural & Resource Economics Society \(NZARES\)](#)** was held in **Wellington** on **August 29-30, 2024**. Three panel sessions focused on important sub-themes, namely "Resilience of New Zealand's Value Chains", "Using Industry Data - Issues, Access, and Confidentiality", and "Climate Policy". NZARES 2024 featured concurrent contributed paper sessions on various topics and a dedicated early career researcher (ECR) session.



Environment and development on the agenda of the 18th EfD Annual Meeting in Nairobi



The [18th Environment for Development \(EfD\) Annual Meeting](#) will take place in **Nairobi**, Kenya, on **October 3-6, 2024**. A Policy Day will be held on October 2. The meeting has become the main global conference on the application of environmental economics in the Global South. This year EfD had over 170 papers submitted from all over the world and expects about 180 people to participate in the meeting. The Annual Meeting proposes also an exciting line-up for the plenary sessions.

EAERE at IPCC: 61st Session in Sofia, 27 July - 2 August 2024

The **61st Session of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC-61)** was held in **Sofia**, Bulgaria, between **July 27 and August 2, 2024**. Aldo Ravazzi Douvan, EAERE Policy Outreach Committee's member, represented EAERE. In Sofia, delegates discussed the timeline for the IPCC's 7th assessment report (AR7) cycle as well as the outlines for the Special Report on "Climate Change and Cities" and the Methodology Report on "Short-lived Climate Forcers", to be published in 2027. While the delegates could not agree on the timeline for AR7 and the decision was delayed, the outline proposals for the two Reports were accepted.

ERC Awarded Projects Update

GREEN TIPPING - From Niches to Norms: Drivers and Diffusion of Green Social Tipping, A. Tavoni

The [Green Tipping](#) project will soon turn one year old, which means that [the team has been recruited](#) and [the first publications are out](#). But the best is yet to come! Two lab experiments and two large online survey experiments are planned in the coming months, while we are also busy developing game theoretic models to study the enabling conditions for (and barriers to) emergent pro-climate collective action. Ultimately, we hope that Green Tipping will advance our understanding of the behavioral, social and institutional drivers of climate action. The output of the theory and experiments will tackle all-important questions such as: what are the most promising interventions to accelerate change towards low-carbon choices? Specifically, under what conditions will targeted interventions trigger social tipping, i.e. crossing critical thresholds where minor changes lead to rapid and irreversible shifts in collective behaviors and norms?
