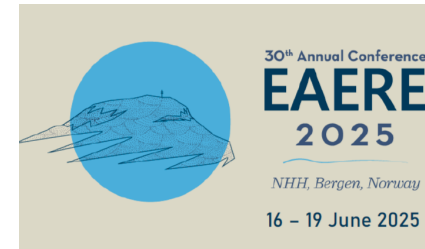
EAERE 2025 Participation Grants: apply by February 10, 2025

EAERE Visiting Programme 2025: Winning Project at KCL by Marta Buso



The project "**Offsetting or reducing? An experimental evaluation of willingness to offset dietary emissions**" by **Marta Buso**, PhD Candidate in Environmental Economics at Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, has been selected for the EAERE 2025 Visiting Programme at King's College London. Demand-based interventions, such as promoting vegetarian/vegan diets, are key to reducing dietary emissions. However, Voluntary Carbon Offsets can also mitigate the negative environmental impact of meat consumption. She plans to conduct two field experiments: one at an international conference and another in the KCL student cafeteria. These experiments will provide further empirical insights into consumer dietary choices and whether fiscal interventions and nudges can reduce diets' environmental impact.

Danish Association of Energy Economics - DAEE: a renewed association



In 2025, the [Danish Association of Energy Economics - DAEE](#), the local affiliate of the International AEE – IAEE, is reviving. The board is headed by the Danish Utility Regulatory Agency, and board members include Denmark Technical University - DTU; Copenhagen Business School - CBS; the Danish Energy Agency; Drivkraft Danmark, Denmark's industry organisation for fuel suppliers and charging operators; Cerius, one of the main Danish electricity distribution system operators, and Energinet, the Danish Transmission system operator. DAEE aims to connect Danish experts in the field of energy economics. DAEE is planning 3 **workshops** that will take place before the summer 2025, and has the ambition to hold the European Association of Energy Economics Conference in 2028.

EAERE at IPBES: 11th Session of the IPBES Plenary report



EAERE was admitted by the IPBES Bureau to take part in the observer process for [11th Session of the IPBES Plenary – IPBES 11](#) which took place in hybrid format on December 10-16, 2024. Italian 6th Catalogue of Environmentally Harmful and Friendly Subsidies

The Italian Ministry of Environment & Energy Security has published the [6th Catalogue of Environmentally Harmful Subsidies \(EHS\) and Environmentally Friendly Subsidies \(EFS\)](#), including Fossil Fuel Subsidies (FFS). It includes estimates for 2022. It is a knowledge report at the service of Parliament, Government and scientific community. It started in 2015 with the Law on Circular Economy and Resource Efficiency. Several other European Countries are also preparing similar catalogues and inventories. Most take inspiration from the OECD work on EHS, FFS and EFR (Environmental Fiscal Reform). Attempts are ongoing at EU level for the phase-out and elimination of EHS and FFS, or their transformation in EFS. They are relevant also in the G7 and G20 negotiations, and in the FCCC and CBD UN conventions.





The IPBES task forces on scenarios and models and on Indigenous and local knowledge are organizing a [workshop to reflect on scenarios and models that better account for different knowledge systems](#), including Indigenous and local knowledge systems, and Mother Earth-centric scenarios and models. The workshop is planned to be held over four days in **Valencia, the Philippines**, in **May 2025**.
