EfD's research developments in the Global South

A team of researchers from the Environment for Development - EfD Global Hub, EfD Nigeria, and international EfD collaborators has been awarded USD 1.9 million to conduct a comprehensive **impact evaluation of agricultural innovations in Nigeria**. Read more [here](#).

Researchers in Cyprus Propose Targeted Measures to Policymakers to Tackle Energy Poverty through Behavioural Insights

Energy poverty is a pressing issue across Europe, at a time when the EU is preparing to launch the Social Climate Fund in 2026 to relieve vulnerable households and small businesses from increased energy costs. Currently, the number of applications submitted in Cyprus by vulnerable households for energy upgrade grants remains low. Cyprus Institute researchers Melina Moleskis, Pantelis Solomou and Theodoros Zachariadis, a member of EAERE's POC, with the collaboration of Meltem Ikinici (World Bank), have published an academic paper and Policy Brief. Using a recently implemented grant scheme as an example, the researchers provide practical advice based on the behavioural barriers that prevent vulnerable households from applying for a grant. For policy makers, fighting energy poverty needs simplifying procedures, reducing hassle and providing clear information and examples that directly address vulnerable households. She has extensively examined the relationship between business cycles and the design and effects of environmental policies.
