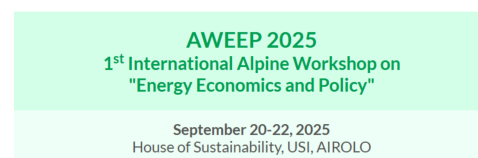
Special discount for the "Training on the EU Vision for Agriculture and Food", June 25-27

12th session of the IPBES plenary on February 3-8, 2025



The Twelfth session of the Plenary of the [Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services - IPBES](#) will take place on **February 3-8, 2025** in the **United Kingdom**. At IPBES 12, the Plenary will consider, among other items, the methodological assessment of the impact and dependence of business on biodiversity and nature's contributions to people (business and biodiversity assessment). Further information will follow in due course.

MED2050 - “The Mediterranean by 2050: A Foresight by Plan Bleu”

The Mediterranean faces increasingly concerning environmental and societal challenges. To help build a resilient future for the region, the **Plan Bleu for environment and development of Mediterranean** has announced the publication of the report aiming at understanding the sustainable development issues in the Mediterranean region and at offering future perspectives for the next 30 years. The [MED2050 report](#) is the result of a collaboration among experts from various Mediterranean countries and fields of expertise. It presents six scenarios for the region's future by 2050. The project aims to inform policy-makers on Mediterranean issues while raising awareness among decision-makers, citizens, particularly the younger generations. MED2050 offers a set of “no-regrets” recommendations for sustainable development, emphasizing the importance of cooperation-based solutions. Israel Launches National Forum for Environmental Economics

This spring marked the launch of the **Israeli Forum for Environmental Economics**, a new national initiative aiming to consolidate and advance the field across research, policy, and practice. The Forum, chaired by Dr. Shiri Zemah-Shamir (School of Sustainability, Reichman University), established following a well-attended foundational meeting, brings together academics, consultants, and public and private sector professionals working at the interface of economics and the environment. Initial priorities include developing a professional network, publishing a quarterly newsletter, hosting an annual conference, and facilitating interdisciplinary research collaborations.
