

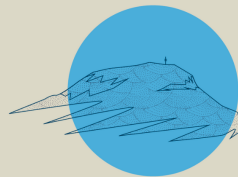

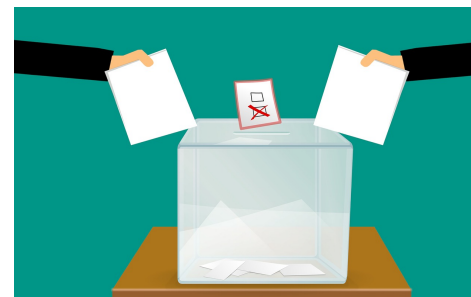

Elections 2025: results are now available

From May 12 to June 19, 2025 **EAERE members voted for a President** (President-Elect in 2026-2027, President in 2028-2029, and Past-President in 2030-2031), **and two Council members** who will serve for four years beginning in 2026. For the position of President, **Karen Pittel** was elected with 48.95% of votes. **Lassi Ahlvik** and **Efthymia Kyriakopoulou** were elected as Council members, with 49.33% and 55.64% of votes respectively. Manchester Workshop on the Economics of Energy Transition - MWEET, December 11-12

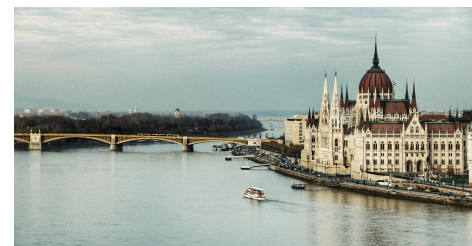

ESABCC new report on EU's 2040 target

The **European Scientific Advisory Board on Climate Change - ESABCC** has published a new report titled "**Scientific advice for amending the European Climate Law - Setting climate goals to strengthen EU strategic priorities**". The ESABCC calls on the European Union to maintain high climate ambition as it revises the European Climate Law to include a 2040 target. The Advisory Board recommends a 90-95% net domestic greenhouse gas emissions reduction by 2040 and stronger adaptation policies to support Europe's long-term interests and reach climate neutrality by 2050. IPBES laid-out summaries for policymakers of Nexus and Transformative Change Assessment Reports

The [Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services - IPBES](#) approved the Thematic Assessment of the Interlinkages Among Biodiversity, Water, Food and Health (**Nexus Assessment**), and the Summary for Policymakers of the Thematic Assessment of the Underlying Causes of Biodiversity Loss and the Determinants of Transformative Change and Options for Achieving the 2050 Vision for Biodiversity (**Transformative Change Assessment**). Laid-out versions of the summaries for policymakers for both reports in English are now available: [Nexus Assessment](#) and [Transformative Change Assessment](#).
