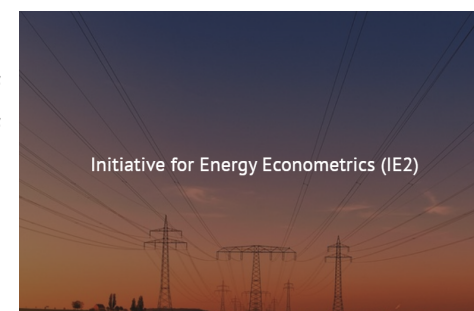

Workshop "Modelling the Economics of Climate Change" on December 11-12



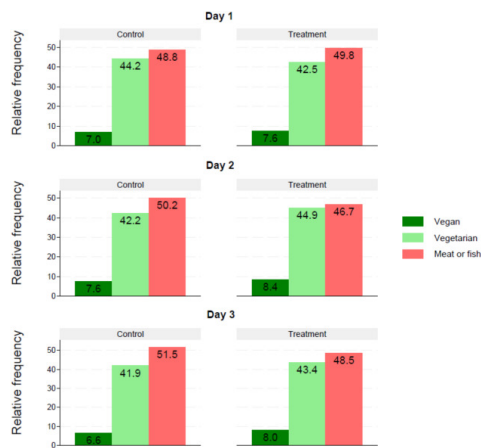

Food choices with increased visibility: EAERE 2022 field experiment



By means of a **field experiment** held at **EAERE 2022**, Astrid Dannenberg, Giorgio Dini, Alessandro Tavoni and Eva Weingärtner investigate whether making food choices more visible encourages more sustainable (meat-free) selections. The findings are analysed in the open-access article ["Food choice with increased visibility – A field experiment at an environmental economics conference"](#). Even among environmentally conscious researchers, showing lunch preferences on conference badges had no significant effect on food choices, suggesting that reputational or "green signaling" effects may already be internalized or discounted in this group. Stronger policy or structural measures may be needed to shift norms around food consumption.

EAERE at the AGORA Conference on November 3-5

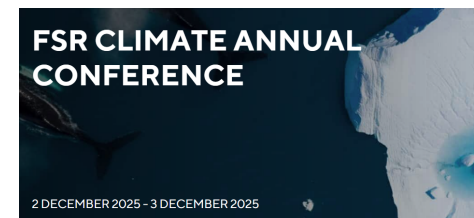
