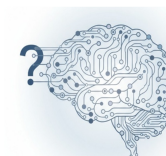

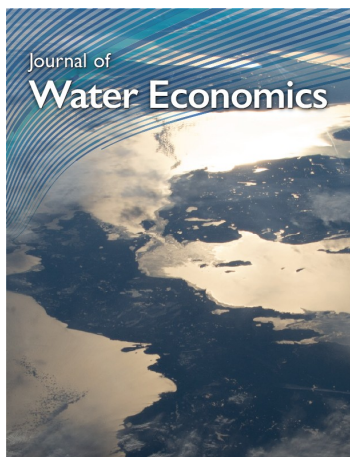

Launch of the Journal of Water Economics



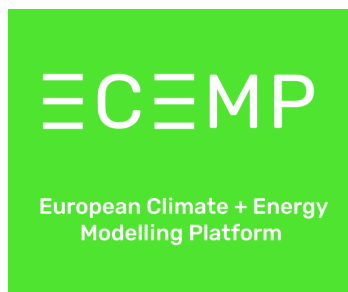
