27th Global Conference on Environmental Taxation (GCET27): Call for Papers

The **27th Global Conference on Environmental Taxation (GCET27)** will take place on 14–16 September 2026 in Berlin, Germany, hosted by the [**Potsdam Institute for Climate Impact Research \(PIK\)**](#). The 2026 edition, titled “Fiscal Instruments for International Climate Action”, will focus on the role of fiscal and market-based instruments, such as carbon pricing, subsidy reform, and international coordination, in supporting effective and equitable climate policies in a global context. The conference programme will address key themes including international cooperation, climate finance and just transitions, and the implementation of policy instruments across sectors and legal frameworks. The **13th Annual Conference of the French Association of Environmental and Resource Economists (FAERE 2026)** will take place on **10–11 September 2026** at the **Université Bourgogne Europe in Dijon (France)**. The conference is organised by [LEDi](#) and [CESAER](#) and is supported by EAERE. [FAERE](#) 2026 aims

to foster the production and dissemination of research in environmental and resource economics, welcoming contributions from both theoretical and applied perspectives across a wide range of topics, including climate, energy, biodiversity, food systems, transportation, and maritime issues. The call for papers is currently open. Full papers must be submitted by **10 April 2026**, with notifications of acceptance expected on **19 May 2026**. 8th Nordic Annual Environmental and Resource Economics Workshop: Call for Papers

The 8th Nordic Annual Environmental and Resource Economics Workshop (NAERE 2026) will take place on 11–12 June 2026 at the [Stockholm School of Economics \(Sweden\)](#). The workshop provides a platform for researchers to present and discuss recent work in environmental and resource economics, fostering exchange within the Nordic research community and beyond. The call for papers is currently open. Authors are invited to submit contributions for presentation at the workshop. Open Research Europe: Launch of the New Phase at CERN

A new phase of [Open Research Europe](#) (ORE) was launched at [CERN](#), marking an important step in the evolution of this European Commission-supported publishing initiative. For the period 2026–2031, ORE will operate as a collectively supported publishing service, backed by a €17 million programme and managed by CERN, extending no-fee publishing opportunities to researchers across 11 European countries and further strengthening the European Research Area. The platform promotes transparency, accessibility, and high standards in publicly funded research through an open peer-review model. [Prof. Dr. Phoebe Koundouri](#) contributes to this initiative as a member of the ORE Advisory Board, as well as through her role as author and reviewer, supporting the development of a more open, inclusive, and impactful research ecosystem in Europe.



53rd EGRIE Seminar and GRIR Colloquium: Call for Papers

The 53rd Seminar of the European Group of Risk and Insurance Economists ([EGRIE](#)) will take place on 20–23 September 2026 in Rennes (France), hosted by SMART in collaboration with CREM and EHESP/UMR Arènes. Submissions are invited on any topic in economics, finance, or management science related to risk and insurance.

In addition, the Geneva Risk and Insurance Group (GRIR) and EGRIE are organising a Colloquium associated with a [special issue on “Transformative Challenges in Agricultural Insurance.”](#) The Colloquium will take place on 23 September 2026, following the seminar. The initiative aims to foster collaboration across scientific communities on risk and risk management in the context of agricultural transformation, with particular attention to challenges related to climate change, agroecological transition, and the digital revolution. PRISMA Summer School 2026: Call for Applications

The Renewable Energy Systems group at the **University of Geneva** is organising the **PRISMA Summer School 2026** on uncertainty in energy system models and integrated assessment models of climate change, to be held in **Geneva (Switzerland)** from **15 to 19 June 2026**. The programme focuses on the role of uncertainty in modelling long-term energy and emissions trajectories to inform policy. It aims to strengthen analytical approaches through lectures, hands-on modelling sessions, and group work, fostering collaboration among participants working on energy and climate modelling. The summer school is targeted at advanced PhD students and early-career researchers with experience in computational modelling and quantitative methods.
